Math:

In Math, we are moving onto Fractions!! We will be working on understanding fractions as a quantity formed by one whole being partitioned into equal parts. We will be learning how to find the equivalence of fraction and compare by reasoning about their size. I have attached a Parent letter for you to review. Take a look at the vocabulary used and the links for videos to help explain this difficult concept.

In Reading, we are reading and looking at the author's viewpoint and how this may be similar or different to our own viewpoint. We will be reading "Esther Morris Gets the Vote", and "The True Story of the Three Little Pigs".

Social Studies/Science:

We have completed a Social Studies test which will be coming home this Friday in the Friday Folders. We will be starting "The Human Body" with Mr.Denman today.

Writing:

Students have working on their first rough draft of their own personal biography. They have completed something similar to this in 2^{nd} grade, so I am looking for more details and facts. They get graded on including illustrations/photos/captions to help comprehension. They will need to include month and year to help document their timeline with detail.
