


A Multiplication and Division Fact Game

×1/1÷, ×2/2÷, ×5/5÷, 10×/10÷



HOW TO PLAY: (2 or more players, best with 4-6 players)

- Students sit in a circle.
- Without looking in the can (or basket), one student pulls 1 card out.
- •He/she must say the fact with the product within 5 seconds. I have them say the complete equation $(2 \times 5 = 10.)$ If he/she is correct, he/she holds onto the card. If he/she is unable to give the correct equation, the card goes back into the can.
- •The can is passed to the next person.
- •If a player pulls the ARRGH! card, he/she must put ALL his/ her cards back into the can and his/her turn is over. (I tell the students they must say ARRGH! like a pirate would ☺)
- •The player with the most cards at the end is the "winner".
