# Classroom News: TIMES

#### Math:

We are learning how to write equations. We have learned the value of the equals sign. Students will determine the unknown whole number in a multiplication or division equation relating three whole numbers. We are solving algebraic problems by find the variable in each equation.

#### Language Arts:

We are continuing reading our second book in a Series Book in Book Clubs. We will deepen our understanding of characters over time by looking at character traits. We will look closely at the setting, plot and theme within the texts. We are focusing on prefixes and suffixes.

<u>Science</u>: Our next unit won't start until after the interims go out. We will complete our Social Studies unit first. We will switch teachers for Science and our next unit will be **Changes** with Ms Wesner.

#### Social Studies:

Our Social Studies unit is based on NC history and Colonial Times. We are learning about how Raleigh was not the original capital. We learning why people moved, and how they moved, from one location to another using the railroad system.
