<u>Math:</u>

We are reviewing our multiplication and division strategies and which one we like to use the most.

Language Arts:

We are finishing our second book in a Series Book in Book Clubs. We will deepen our understanding of characters over time by looking at character traits. We are looking carefully at identify the character in the book and how she changes from the beginning to the end. We are focusing on prefixes and suffixes and their meaning.

<u>Science</u>: Our next unit won't start until after 5th December when Interims go out. We will complete our Social Studies unit first. We will switch teachers for Science and our next unit will be **Changes** with Ms Wesner.

Social Studies:
